

Privacy Policy for World Language Institute in Roswell, Fulton County, GA

Please read the following to learn about Language World Language Institute, WLI ("we", or "the Company") privacy policy. This privacy policy does not apply to practices of organizations or individuals that WLI does not own or control, or to people that WLI does not control or manage; it applies solely to information collected by WLI.

Information Gathered. WLI gathers information from members and guests who apply for the various services WLI offers. This information may include, but is not limited to: first name, last name, mailing address, telephone number, email address, foreign language skills, and credit card number or checking account information for payment. Additionally, WLI may gather information that is not personally identifiable, such as browser type and IP address.

Use of Information Obtained. WLI primarily uses email addresses submitted by members to send news regarding services, but the user may choose not to receive email of this type by [contacting us](#). Email addresses may also be used in private correspondence with the user for customer service issues. Financial information that is collected is used to bill the user for products and services. All other private information submitted by the user is confidential and will not be disclosed except as required by law or to protect members of WLI. All private information can be updated or deleted by the user at any time. WLI uses server, IP address, and browser-type related information in the general administration of our website.

Children. When a child under age 18 wants to register with WLI, we ask that he or she have a parent or legal guardian register on his or her behalf. We will not contact children under age 13 without a parent's or legal guardian's permission.

Sharing of the Information. Except where a member is expressly informed otherwise or as described below, we do not sell, rent, share, trade or give away any of your personal information except to the financial institution that processes your credit card or check transaction unless required by law or for the protection of your membership.

Use of Cookies. A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's hard drive containing information about the user. We may occasionally use cookies to anonymously track and target the interests of our users to enhance the experience on our site or for advertising tracking purposes. We do not and will not use cookies to collect private information from any user. If a user rejects a cookie, they may still use our site. The only drawback to this is that the user may be limited in some areas on our site.

Changes in Our Privacy Policy. Language Door may update this policy. We will notify you about significant changes in the way we treat personal information by sending a notice to the mail address or email address you provide in your membership registration, or such other mail or email address as you may later provide to WLI.

Security. WLI takes every precaution to protect our users' information. All of our users' information, not just the sensitive information mentioned above, is restricted in our offices. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example a billing clerk or a customer service representative) are granted access to personally identifiable information.
